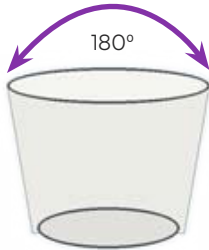


Extendable Pot Trolleys

Set Up Guide

Set up in 5 simple steps

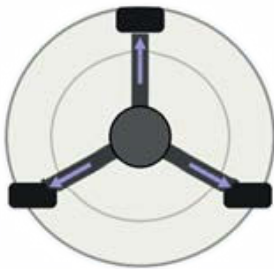

EMPTY POT • TURN UPSIDE DOWN

Step 1: Prepare the pot Remove the plant, soil and any other contents. Place the empty pot upside down on a clean, flat surface. Protect the rim if required.

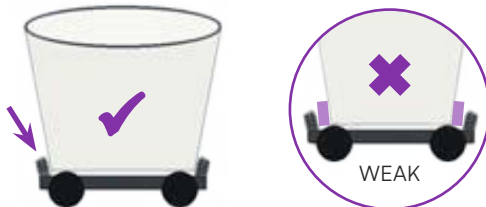

WHEELS FACE UP • HUB CENTRED

Step 2: Position the trolley Turn the trolley upside down so all three wheels face upwards. Place the centre hub over the centre of the pot base.

EXTEND ALL 3 ARMS EVENLY

Step 3: Adjust all three arms Slide out each arm and ensure each arm is snugly fitted to the edge of the pot on all sides, to evenly distribute the load/weight of the pot plant. Lock wheels to secure. Keep the centre hub centred. The three support points should sit evenly beneath the solid base of the pot. Over-extending the arms will cause trolley to buckle under the weight.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE SETTING UP

DO: Use only with a pot size and weight within the trolley product rating. Adjust and centre the trolley on the base of an empty, inverted pot. Ensure unit is on a level surface for stability. We recommend the use of safety gloves and boots for protection.

DON'T: Position a loaded pot onto trolley on the floor.

HOLD TOGETHER • TURN UPRIGHT

Step 4: Turn upright together Hold the empty pot and trolley firmly together. Carefully turn both over as one unit so the wheels contact the floor. Keep hands clear of the wheels.

CHECK STABILITY BEFORE USE

Step 5: Check before loading On a level surface, gently press the pot at three points. Confirm the pot is centred, all three wheels sit flat and the trolley does not rock. Adjust again if needed, then load the pot.
